Who do we serve?

Everyone is welcome to come and eat from the van. There is no criteria to who should be served. We all have different needs and S.O.U.L. Soup Patrol aim is to make a difference in the lives of those we serve.

How can you help?

Below is areas where you can be of assistance.

The run is divided into two halves:-

1. Preparation of the bread rolls and packing the van. This starts at 2.30 to 4.00pm.
2. Delivering the food. This is from 4.00 pm to 7.00pm.
3. We also pick up the bread from Baker's Delight at Rockingham Shopping Centre on Wednesday and Saturday.
4. We pick up chickens from Chicken Treat twice a week.
5. We pick up roast beef & sausages from Gourmet Butcher in old Rockingham once a week.
6. We pick up twice a week from Woolworths (if there is anything available)
7. We pick up soup once a week from Prestige Catering.
8. Vegetables are picked up from Malibu Fresh once a week and taken to the soup kitchen.
9. We rely on donations given money and these gifts are tax deductible.
10. We rely on donations of food, blankets, coats, scarves, beanies, socks etc. We thank all our sponsors and benefactors because without them we would not be able to provide this service.

What do I need to do?

Lisa Rogan-Coonz is volunteer co-ordinator of S.O.U.L. Soup Patrol. She can be contacted on 0432158088 . All volunteers are required to have a police clearance or a working with children form. This can be obtained through Australia Post. There will be an orientation day before you start the run to explain what is expected of a volunteer and to familiarize you with safe food practices. Children under 16 can help with the preparation but because of insurance restrictions only 16 and above can go out on the run.
